The City of Airway Heights has recently completed replacement of the existing bus shelter in front of Yokes and have added a new shelter near Zips Restaurant and another in front the Zip Trip convenience store, all three are along

SR-2. There is still some additional landscaping that will be installed at the two shelters near Zips and Zip Trip. Along with a more modern appearance there is also a bike rack at each bus shelter for the convenience of our residents who are bikers.

In addition to adding these bus shelters, the City is considering adding a few bus benches without shelters at other STA bus stops within the city to further provide for the comfort of residents who utilize the public transportation system.
