## Committee Seeks Partners

As the city grows and prospers, effective change must be planned; this committee will be in the forefront in making some of those decisions. In addition, an



idea suggested by some of the committee members in attendance would designate certain business owners within an established block along the corridor to be block "captains". These designated individuals would represent and coordinate their block's wishes as it pertains to improvements along their section of the corridor. These captains will also in-

formally brief the other business owners of that block what was discussed at previous meetings. Again, the committee, with the city's help, is committed to establishing a business organization to foster and sustain business growth along the important Highway 2 corridor.

## Initial Corridor Block Designs Suggested

Our partners at ALSC Architects, in cooperation with WSDOT, have come up with a few concepts. These concepts were based on the committee's input on dealing with some of the issues facing the businesses along the north

corridor of Highway 2. Although the concept was depicted on a dry board the "sketch" solicited various comments from those attending our last meeting. Suggestions such as creating an entertainment district along with the concepts depicted were dis-

cussed openly by business owners and other city and local representatives. The City will continue to work with ALSC Architects to devise a strategic concept of the corridor as it relates to the City's newly adopted comprehensive plan.
