H-2 Business Corridor Plan Materializing

The City of Airway Heights' businesses, residents, and associated parties have hammered out an initial concept of what the H-2 corridor should look like for the foreseeable future. Ideas have emerged that represent the vision and goals stated in the comprehensive plan. An architect from ALSC has gathered all the initial concepts, ideas and suggestions and will incorporate them in a rendering to be presented possibly at the next scheduled meeting. Understandably this conceptual rendering will go through a couple more iterations before the City has a working plan to implement. As agreed by the committee the approach to implement the overall strategy should be done by "blocks" whereas workable and less costly sections of the



strategy will be worked first. The sections of the corridor strategy requiring more planning and coordination will be worked more slowly. The Committee will be working with WSDOT to coordinate our efforts that affect the actual traffic patterns and median landscaping of the corridor. WSDOT has been very receptive to the com-

mittee's initial suggestions and looks forward to seeing that the corridor not only provide a means of getting from point A to B but also be aesthetically appealing, pedestrian friendly, and business conducive. The committee encourages everyone to participate in planning for the growth of the City of Airway Heights.
